To know the effect of different sketching pencils (review Y4 work) To know how pencils are classified - hard=(H) soft/blackness=(B). Understand the significance of number e.g. 4B is softer than 2B.

To understand what **texture** is and how it can be created using a variety of media including pencil, oil pastel, clay and plaster.

To develop the skill of pencil sketching (Y4) and how to use **tone** and **mark making** to create accurate observational drawings.


To review monoprinting (Y3) and develop this skill using oil pastels.
