


manufactured		The food choices we make affect people and nature in many different places.	
supply chain		The total exports of all goods worldwide from the UK for January 2023 was £30.1 billion and total import to the UK was £54.6 billion.	
trade		The goods we buy come from all over the world. There are many steps in a global supply chain before the goods get to us. Transporting goods to and from a factory involves huge distances and needs careful planning.
