SAFE APP DOWNLOADS

There are countless apps readily available for download on all types of devices. Children often hear of apps through word of mouth, ads or watching a content creator promote them.

- To make sure an app is safe to use, keep these things in mind: • Check ratings - When your child wants to download an app, review the ratings carefully. Keep an eye out for
- inappropriate content, in-app purchases and targeted ads. • Permissions - Check what permissions an app is asking for.

Look out for permissions involving camera access and personal data, disable any that you don't want accepted.
